OVERVIEW

Key	Essence	Description
#1	Set a Time Think of a time when you can be intentional and consistent. The morning and before bed are highly recommended but remember it's a daily walk that can happen anytime.	Psalm 5:3 (KJV) My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O Lord; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee and will look up.
#2	Set a Place Get away from all distractions and focus on Him.	Matthew 6:6 (ICB) When you pray, you should go into your room and close the door. Then pray to your Father who cannot be seen. Your Father can see what is done in secret, and he will reward you.
#3	Prayer Thank Him, confess, repent, and share everything on your heart that will not go away. Talk to Him just like you talk to a friend.	Jeremiah 33:3 (KJV) Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.
#4	Bible Study Start with a verse, then move to reading Bible stories from the Bible, then move on to studying Biblical concepts.	Psalm 119:105 (ICB) Your word is like a lamp for my feet and a light for my way.
#5	Stop and Listen Silence can be scary for some people, but try it...Don't talk, just listen and wait for Him to speak...this is when He can really reveal His love to you.	John 10:27-28 (ICB) My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never die. And no person can steal them out of my hand
#6	Accept & Believe He will always make His way clear, accept that He knows best and follow Him.	Proverbs 3:5-7 (ICB) Trust the Lord with all your heart. Don't depend on your own understanding. Remember the Lord in everything you do. And he will give you success. Don't depend on your own wisdom. Respect the Lord and refuse to do wrong.
